Guided Reading Prompts and Questions to Improve ...

As an alternative, ask a speculative question and give students the opportunity to make a prediction. "What do you think you'll learn about this topic from the text you'll be reading?" Finally, have students answer the "L" (What have I learned?) question during the reading (or after they've completed it). When a reader identifies what they're learning as they read, metacognition is improved.

Guided Reading Questions to Prompt Discussion - Guided Readers

Questions to Ask During Guided Reading During reading, the teacher goes from one student to the next for a quick conference. You can conference for a student's grow goal, for

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fluency and decoding, or for the lesson's strategy. You can also conference for comprehension. For Decoding or Solving Unknown Words¹! Find the part that's not quite right.

Questions to Ask During Guided Reading

Read a book or text to the class, and model your thinking and questioning. Emphasize that even though you are an adult reader, questions before, during, and after reading continue to help you gain an understanding of the text you are reading. Ask questions such as: "What clues does the title give me about the story?"

Questions Before, During, and After Reading ...

Describe how you think the main character feels in the beginning of the story. Describe the main character's feelings at the end of the story. 3. Explain the main idea of the story by retelling it in your own words. 4. Summarize the main facts in the story and discuss how they relate to the main idea of the story. 5.

Reading Comprehension Questions
