c. Design Guidelines. i. Where located along the facade of any building containing a customer entrance, where adjacent to any customer parking area, where the gross ground floor area of a development exceeds 50,000 square feet, and where otherwise deemed appropriate by the Community Development Director to promote pedestrian safety or accessibility, such walkways shall be a minimum width of eight feet.

Chapter 18.58 RETAIL DESIGN GUIDELINES AND STANDARDS

• Shopping centers shall be unified with a thematic design and be consistent in the type of materials, scale, and architectural features utilized. • New buildings should compliment surrounding buildings in terms of scale, design, and context, but should be unique in nature. Mimicry of architectural periods of the past is discouraged.
